

## TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR EVENTCENTER TECHNOLOGY:

### Browser Test:

All Event Center users/viewers must access the meeting with an HTML 5 supported web browser. To confirm if you are ready to participate in a web meeting, please take the browser test:

### Minimum System Requirements:

- 2.0Ghz Processor or faster
- 2 GB RAM (Greater than 2 GB recommended)

### Minimum Browser Requirements:

Browser must support HTML-5. To detect your browser version, run <https://whichbrowser.net/>

- Windows 7 or later
- Mac OS X 10.9 or later
- Chrome 60 or greater
- Firefox 52 or greater
- Edge 14 or greater
- Safari 10 or greater
- iOS 10 or greater
- Internet Explorer 11
